Jody Franck presented the Treasurer's report. There was a unanimous vote to accept the treasurer's report as is.

There was a discussion of the 2019 budget. There are no corrections or changes to the budget, except with the assessment that was figured out for 2019. Marilyn Cheever accepted the budget as presented. Jeff Leuth seconded that motion.

There was a discussion of possible members to be on the parish council with two members terms ending tonight.

Annual meetings will be held in each of the churches after worship services on January 20th, 2019.

There was a motion to adjourn the meeting by Deanne Gaalswyk and seconded by Jeff Leuth.

Next Parish Council Meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 12, 2019 at 6 pm at Trinity.

JANUARY 20, 2019

President John Borchardt called the meeting to order.

An additional item was added to the new business on the assessments on the streets in town.

Devotions were given by Pastor Anthony. We used the litany on the inside of the back cover of the annual report booklet.

A motion by Bob Moffitt, seconded by Joel Detert was made to approve the Secretary's report. Motion carried. The Treasurer's report was looked at. The cost of insurance was higher than budgeted. The rates had just gone up that much. We will probably have to look at other insurance when it comes due. Guide One did not offer to renew Waverly. Scott Morrow made a motion, seconded by Bob Moffitt to accept the Treasurer's report as

presented. Motion carried.

The budget was gone over. Currently there is \$350 budgeted for registration for the synod assembly. It was brought up that we might get someone to go if the congregation added the cost of room and board to the budget for the attendance at the assembly. Mary Ann Frerichs made a motion to increase the amount budgeted for the synod assembly to \$600.00. Bob Moffitt seconded. Motion carried.

Jean Schock made a motion to approve the budget, Jon Saxen seconded. Motion carried.

The Pastor drew attention to upcoming events. One is Saturday, February 23, 2019 at Willmar from 8:30 a.m to 3:30 p.m. on Equipping Congregations Day which helps congregations with ideas to promote the church. The cost is \$50 for the day no matter how many people attend from the congregation. Pastor will be going. He also brought up that Easter is later this year. Ash Wednesday is March 6th and Easter is Sunday, April 21. There will be no Easter Vigil this year.

There was NO OLD BUSINESS.

The Nominating Committee report shows that there are still several positions to be filled. The treasurer position is still open along with positions still open on other committees. Bob Moffitt made a motion to approve the people taking positions per the report. Henry Borchardt seconded the motion. Motion carried. John Borchardt thanked the ones accepting positions and thanked the ones that were going off for their service.

NEW BUSINESS

The City of Welcome is planning to make some major upgrades to the water and sewer mains and streets. It will entail several different streets some of which are Campbell and blocks of 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th streets. Construction is being done by the city. The assessment will be on the 2020 taxes. The cost estimate is \$60 to \$80 per foot of frontage and the church has 150 feet of frontage so the cost will probably be between \$9,000 and \$12,000 which will be billed over a number of years. The city is proposing to not put a sidewalk on the west side of the church. There will be curb and gutter put in.

Summer worship rotation was discussed. The attendance has been declining so the Parish Council is talking of rotating the Wednesday night services so it may not be in August when Trinity has Wednesday night services. Bob Moffitt said to try different months to see if it helps. This will be taken back to the Parish Council.

Building Renovation Plan

Needs we have for the church to be kept in repair. John B. handed out a sheet with a list of projects of things

that need to be done. The one of top priority is repair to the stained glass windows for an estimated cost of \$28,000. The windows on the south side have issues that need to be addressed soon. The north side isn't quite as bad. When the windows are repaired they will be made so they cannot be opened anymore.

Other items included siding for an estimated cost of \$100,000 of which we can pick and choose what we want done as the cost includes some repairs around the stained glass windows which we know will need to be done if/when we have the windows worked on. This cost is for steel siding. Vinyl siding would run around \$10,000 and \$15,000 less than steel siding.

The cost for new carpeting would be approximately \$26,000. The carpet we have now was installed in 1976 and could use some updating. The pricing includes the offices and entry ways.

How to finance the updates/repairs was discussed. We could use some of the money from savings and we could hold fundraisers.

Also mentioned was the ceiling in the church which can probably be fixed by members of the church as it just needs to be tacked up.

Basement windows on the south side were included in the siding bid plus some other windows and doors.

Becky Detert made a motion to put together a committee to get details on the costs of the items with some options and come up with some fundraisers. The deadline to have some information put together would be around the first part of May. Scott seconded the motion. Motion carried. People that volunteered to be on the committee were Scott Morrow, Tim Stahl, Bob Moffitt, John Borchardt and the property committee will also be on it.

Jon Saxen made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Audrey Swanson. Motion carried.



January 13, 2019 9:00 am

The meeting was called to order.

Agenda: motion was **made** to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Secretary's Report: Minutes from last meeting were read. Motion to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report: The operating statement was reviewed by the members present. \$25,000 moved from the CD to the Checking account. A withdrawal from the Endowment fund was made to cover the grants that were approved. 2018 and 2019 Budgets were reviewed. Further review will be made at the Annual Meeting. Motion was made to approve the budget. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report: There will be a conference on February 23rd, from 8:30-3:30 in Wilmar, with speakers and workshops. The event is titled Equipping Congregations. The cost is \$80 for the entire congregation or \$150 for the Circle of Faith Parish. Pastor Anthony is planning to attend. He invited others to attend. Any number of attendees is covered by the fee. Easter is later in the spring this year. Ash Wednesday is March 6th at St. Peter at 6:30pm. Lenten Eve services are March 13, and April 4 at Waverly. Meals are pending on Youth Group. The Annual Meeting is scheduled for January 20 at 7pm.

Worship Committee: Will meet prior February 10th, the worship schedule is planned through the end of the year.

Caring Ministries: Mary Lou and Belva continue to do monthly visits and communion. The Quilts were delivered to Gloria Dei. Belva contacted Hope Lodge in Rochester. They are a chemo unit. Jon will deliver quilts to them on his next visit to Rochester.

Property Committee: Will reach out to for bids on the downstairs bathroom.

Faith Formation: The Christmas program was on December 16. It was very well done. Thank you to Lacey for coordinating.

Parish Council: Summer worship schedule will be reviewed at the Annual Meeting with the change of rotating the Wednesday evening services.

Endowment: The grants have been approved and there will be distribution ceremony announced at a later date. A suggestion was made to have an Endowment Sunday where the focus would be on finding new opportunities.

Old Business: Jon continues working on updating the cemetery records. Insurance is in progress. The deductible will be raised but will have lower premiums.

New Business: Discussion on having back up check signers for certain council positions. This makes sense. Tim presented information on Emmaus Road Ministries. It is an organization formed to address the crisis of homeless children in Columbia, specifically their education. There is a scholarship program where children can be sponsored. Tim will present at the Annual Meeting as well. The Nomination Committee is currently seeking new members. There still several positions open. Parish Council is currently represented but it would be beneficial to have a third member as the 2 remaining member both go off next year. Annual Meeting will be held January 20th at 7pm. The next Council meeting will be April 7th at 9am prior to service.

Motion made to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. The Lord's Prayer was recited.



Sunday January 20, 2019 7PM

Steve Williamson called the meeting to order. 27 Members present and Pastor Anthony.

Devotions/Litany led by Pastor Anthony.

Secretary's Report: Minutes read from the 2018 Annual meeting. Motion was made to accept and seconded. Motion carried.

Treasure's Report: 2018 Year-end Statement presented. 2019 Budgets were reviewed for Waverly. It was noted that Propane came in over budget. Worship came in under budget as did property. A total loss of \$2,361.11 under budget for the year. It was noted that \$25,000 of the CD was transferred to the Endowment account. Discussion surrounding the Giving numbers. \$7000 more in giving would aid in coming in at budget. If each family gave even \$100 more this might make up the difference. Motion was made to accept the budgets and seconded. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report: Pastor's report was submitted on page 3 of the flyer. Upcoming events of interest include the Equipping Congregations Conference on February 23 in Wilmar. Pastor encouraged members to attend. Pastor Anthony indicated that St. Peter will be hosting the Ash Wednesday Service this year. The Wednesday evening services will be March 13 and April 3 at Waverly at 6:30 pm. There will be no Easter Vigil this year.

Motion made to accept the Pastor's report was made and seconded. Motion carried.

Endowment Report: This is the 2nd year of the Endowment fund. \$25,000 was moved from the CD to Endowment Fund. There will be an Endowment Sunday scheduled to distribute the grants and encourage the congregation to expand their thinking on ways to utilize the funds. Motion made to accept the Endowment Fund report was made and seconded. Motion Carried.

Old Business: The Steeple has not been addressed. This discussion will be continued in 2019.

Nominating Committee Report: Listing of the 2019 Nominees was presented. Motion to accept a unanimous ballot was made and seconded. Motion carried. It was noted that Faith Formation and Circle of Faith Parish members still need recruitment. Nancy Nordstrom was elected to Parish Council. Lynette and Susan were elected to be Synod Delegates. A motion made to accept these nominations, seconded and carried.

New Business: The Summer rotation change was discussed. Waverly will host Wednesday evening services in August this year. Motion made to accept, seconded and carried. Tim presented on Emmaus Ministries. It is an organization formed to address the crisis of homeless children in Columbia, specifically their education. There is a scholarship program where children can be sponsored. Tim will gather more information and present to the congregation. No other New Business. Motion to Adjourn was made, seconded, and carried.
