Step 1

Length: 250 word maximum (approximately two paragraphs)

Step 2

Choose a Bible verse that is important to you.

Step 3

Write a short prayer. (approximately one to two sentences)

Step 4

Submit your devotion to the parish office by **Sunday, February 16**th.

St. Peter Annual Meeting

The St. Peter Annual Meeting was called to order by President Marilyn Cheever following the church service on January 26, 2020.

Pastor Eric led the litany prayer.

Motion by Jim Plumhoff, seconded by Angie Schmidt to accept the 2019 Annual meeting minutes as presented in the annual report. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was discussed. The Youth fund was closed at the bank with the balance transferred to the general fund. Motion to accept as printed by Sherry Schmidt, seconded by Jeannine Rasmussen and passed.

Circle of Faith and St. Peter's budget were discussed. The military pays health insurance for the Christoffels so the actual spent for insurance is less than the budgeted expense. The leak in the back minister's room has been repaired but some plaster, painting etc. needs to be done this summer. That is the only needed repair known at this time. Total 2020 budget is \$4500 more than the 2019 budget with the parish expense being the increase. St. Peter's will pay Circle of Faith \$10, 339.72 per quarter. Motion to accept both budgets was made by Jeannine, seconded by Kathryn Detert and passed.

Summer Wednesday evening service will be held in Ceylon during the month of August.

Marilyn told of the editorial changes on the synod assembly constitution. Voice vote accepted the changes as printed.

Our Anniversary is scheduled for June 28 with a joint service at 10 am. Committee is working on details.

Tithe-ly process of giving money electronically is availanyone at St. Peter's wants to use it, contact Marilyn or the church office for details.

Our water softener system is old and not working well. No one buys salt now. It needs to be looked at, maybe updated. We pay a once a year fee to Culligan — most likely for rent of equipment. Jim will look into the system.

Tom Beckendorf has checked our water heater. It is a Federated heater and is working fine.

Money counters, head ushers, janitor, organist and council members will continue for another year.

Motion to adjourn by Jim, seconded by Kathy Bremer and passed.

The Christmas project of the Estherville Ministerial Association was highly successful again. 597 people were served. It takes 25 + volunteers to accomplish this. It was reported our 21 quilts were very much appreciated. Every family receives a quilt.

Ann reports a WELCA treasury balance of \$504.74 as of 12/31. \$100 each was given to Ceylon Fire Dept. Ceylon 1st responders, Ceylon Thanksgiving, CREST, Heaven's Table, Martin County Youth for Christ, Habitat for Humanity, Options Pregnancy Center, Salvation Army. \$225 was received for the Thankoffering.

We had 6 workers for our first day of quilting and 8 the 2nd day with 23 quilts made. In February we meet the 12 & 13 and the 26 & 27. January 22 & 23 workdays were cancelled.

Our Bible Camp has 2 retreats in February - The 7-9 is called Generations. (Mixed age groups from congregations learn how to foster conversation across generations). A marriage retreat is Feb. 14-16. Both of these are at Okoboji.


