As you may have already heard, the wearing of face masks in public places (i.e. grocery stores, etc.) is recommended. Some members of Partners in Ministry in Trimont have begun making cloth face masks. Stephanie and I have been collecting these masks and bringing them to the Town Center grocery store in Trimont for people to take if they need one. We initially dropped off 37 masks and a day and a half later they were gone. There is an urgent need for face masks to protect each other.

How to Make Masks

If you have the ability to sew cloth face masks, please consider making some. If you need materials or patterns, please contact the parish office. Those who are Thrivent members could also apply for a \$250 Action Card to help cover material costs. If you aren't a Thrivent member, but need some assistance with covering material costs, please contact the parish office. Completed masks can be dropped off at the parish office or let us know and someone will pick them up from your house.

How to Get a Mask

If you or someone you know are in need of a mask, please contact the parish office or stop by the Town Center in Trimont. As masks become available, we will make sure that you get one.




