Our in-person worship services are going well. Thank you for being flexible and willing to follow the guidelines to allow us to resume our worship services in our buildings! With executive order 20-81, issued by the Minnesota Governor, face masks are required for all indoor gatherings at Circle of Faith churches. This includes all worship services, meetings, and Bible studies.

If you do not feel comfortable attending in-person worship services, meetings, or Bible studies, we do have a Zoom account. This account allows anyone with internet access to participate in the life of our parish without putting themselves at risk by entering the building. In the month of August, our 10:30 am worship service will be made available online through Facebook (Circle of Faith Parish's page), YouTube and Zoom. The YouTube and Facebook videos will be available to watch at a later time.

AFFIRMATION OF BAPTISM

The Confirmation Rite is a major milestone in our Christian faith. It is a time to affirm the decision our parents made when we were infants to have us baptism into this faith. Normally this happens in the spring or fall during our regular worship services. However, due to this pandemic, we have been unable to complete this confirmation rite for six of our members who have completed their confirmation instruction and requirements.

Because of the current restrictions, the confirmation rite will take place outside of our regular worship services. This will allow the students to go through the confirmation rite together with their families and godparents. The Rite of Confirmation at St. Peter will be on Sunday, September 27th at 1:30 pm. This will be a private service for the three confirmands. Trinity's has not been finalized yet but will take place this fall.
