In the coming weeks, we will be adding the liturgy back into our worship services. We also know more about the virus now and it is definitely airborne, but it does not remain on surfaces for very long. As we add the liturgy back, we will also begin using the hymnals again.

We will continue with our live streaming of the worship service on Sundays at 10:30 am. For the month of October, that means we will be live streaming the worship service at Trinity. We will be using new equipment to live stream those services. Please be patient as we work through any technical issues that may come up. The service will be available through Circle of Faith Parish's Facebook page and the Circle of Faith Parish YouTube channel.



Confirmation class will begin for 7th and 8th graders on Wednesday, October 7th. Classes will be held at Trinity from 4:00 – 5:00 pm every other week. Meeting was called to order by Marilyn Cheever

Representatives from Immanuel Lutheran in Dunnell, LeAnn Swanson and Dale Knuth came to gather information about possibly joining Circle of Faith. They are splitting with their current church partner and looking at options. The pastor currently serving them is retiring.

Motion to approve agenda as printed was made by Jody Franck and seconded by Nancy Nordstrom, approved.

Pastor Anthony shared a devotion based on John 15: 1-5.

Motion to approve July 21, 2020 minutes was made by Tim Peterson and seconded by John Borchardt, approved.

<u>Pastor's Report</u> – vacation was good. He will be gone October 8-11 for a family wedding. Pam Tracy from Jackson is lined up for pulpit supply for St. Peter and Trinity. There will be no communion as she is a lay leader. Fall Theological conference is October 12 and 13 via zoom. Confirmation services will be September 27 at St. Peter and October 18 at Trinity, other than a representative of the congregation it will be a family service due to space. Confirmation classes will be starting in October. A different approach is being tried. They will have a short video to watch ahead of class that will be discussed during class. They will meet twice a month from 4:00-5:00. Pastor is continuing to learn about streaming. Easier to operate equipment will soon be used.

Congregation Reports

Waverly had a break-in in May. They are updating video equipment.

Trinity will soon have a tenant, Martin County Farm Management will be renting space beginning in October.

St. Peter is going to go to communion twice a month, the first and last Sunday.

Old Business

Area parish letter – Immanuel in Dunnell responded resulting in tonight's visit. The president of First Lutheran in Trimont also talked to Marilyn, they are dissolving their partnership with the Methodist church. We need to think about timeline and how to proceed, we need to be mindful of where we are headed.

Associate pastor position – internship application – We won't get anyone this September, Wartburg has contacted us as to whether we want to apply for next year – it is felt it is a good option to keep open so Pastor will complete the paperwork.

New Business

Pastor Eric's resignation letter – Marilyn read the letter, Jody Franck made a motion to accept it and Nancy Nordstrom seconded, approved with one no vote.

Christmas worship schedule was discussed, much to think about with current restrictions. Church councils will discuss.

Thanksgiving service will be at St. Peter, it is their month for Wednesday services.

Food Shelf/Food insecurities

Pastor had a conversation with the person in Trimont who administers the program there. He was surprised how far people were coming from to get food from them. The need is growing. There have been some farmers donate meat. He is wondering what we might be able to do. He shared pictures of something he saw on vacation, it was an outdoor "cupboard" with a take what you need, leave what you can. It was asked if that was workable in the winter. Vandalism was also brought up. A suggestion of a table with extra garden produce might be a place to start. Another suggestion was bags of groceries handed out after church service. Brainstorming at this point.

It was brought up that we should possibly consider additional compensation to Pastor Anthony during the time he is handling all the pastoral duties. It could come from what is already in the budget for Pastor Eric's salary.

Next meeting will be October 13, 2020 Motion to adjourn was made by John Borchardt and seconded by Tim Peterson, approved.

We discussed the profit and loss sheet from January 1 through August 26, 2020. Aubrey clarified some numbers. Our current sharing agreement payment was paid by the federal grant received. Thank you to Jon Saxen for his skill and work securing this grant. St. Peter's checkbook is in good shape and the savings account at Ceylon Bank has not been touched.

Dale has worked on the drinking fountain in the kitchen—it leaks. He will contact Tom Beckendorf to close the water line to it..

Our church will continue to meet at 8:30 am. Sundays during September and October. St. Peter's will take its turn at the 6:30 pm Wednesday service during November.

Darrel Klenz is retiring from head usher position. Thank you, Darrel, for your years of service.


