Times will stay this way until June of 2025, when they will rotate again.

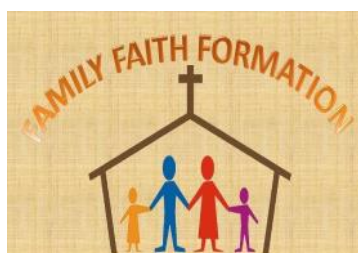

This summer Circle of Faith Parish will be worshipping with texts from a sermon series focusing on grace, joy, and abundance. Each month we will have a new theme.

Where typically on the Revised Common Lectionary we sample texts from the Old Testament, Psalm, Epistles, and Gospel, this series will spend more time on the events of a particular part of scripture. We will be digging deeper into the themes we encounter in the bible and getting familiar with the story as it takes place.

This is a great opportunity to dig deeper into our faith and possibly encounter unfamiliar stories about how God loves the world.
