

Waverly Council

Waverly Council met on Sunday, June 23, 2024 after pour morning worship. President Troy Schmidtke resided over the meeting.

Deanne passed out the Treasurer's Summary Report. Money has been distributed to the Sunday school, 125th Anniversary Committee, Roof Fund, Youth Convention and Choir leaving a balance of \$85,264.98. MM by Tom and seconded by Gwen to accept the report.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Motion made by Tom and seconded by Deanne to increase the janitorial fee for weddings and funerals
 and special events at the church from \$50 to \$100. The funeral booklet and funeral homes will need to be
 contacted.
- The church has been informed by Verizon we no longer have a working phone which was primarily used in the elevator. Verizon to be contacted regarding reimbursement for the months it wasn't working and to clarify this matter. We do need a designated number to pass inspection.
- The Youth Convention in New Orleans is soon approaching. Still need \$200 per person (3 students, 1 chaperone from Waverly). MM and seconded to apply for fund through the Endowment Fund.
- Deanne reported Schmidt Bakery will give us a discount on donuts which will be purchased for the Anniversary.
- Tom reported the Caring Ministry Team continues their monthly visits t shut-ins.
- Discussion concerning the roof and steeple repair took place. Still waiting for a sub-contractor to do the steeple.
- It was suggested that if this project can't be done by August, we would wait until after the Anniversary.

NEW BUSINESS:

- The north church entrance railing has been scraped and repainted. We have an estimate from Carpet Plus to remove and replace the carpet on the steps. Payment would be due at time of ordering. MM by Cliff and seconded by Deanne to go forward in picking out new carpet and having Carpet Plus put it on.
- Pastor informed us he would like regular Circle of Faith youth meetings. (Gr. 7-12) and is asking if we could encourage members to be leaders of this group and give the names to Pastor Kelly
- It was decided to have more frequent council meetings. Suggested was the 3rd Sunday every other month.

We closed with the Lord's Prayer. No further business, MM by Deanne and seconded by Gwen to adjourn.


